

# Houston Health Department 2023-2024 Weekly Influenza Report Syndromic Surveillance

MMWR Week 2024 17 (ending 04/27/2024)

# Key Highlights:


Historically, the influenza season begins around the first of October, usually MMWR Week 40. Last season (2022-2023), HHD observed an uptick in influenza prior to Week 40. Because of this slight change in timeline from the traditional influenza season, all figures in this report currently begin on Week 35. There is a 7 day lag for state and national values reported. Last 5 weeks of syndromic data are subject to change.

Figures begin on page 3 of this report. Please note that wastewater was not sampled for 2024 Week 3 due to weather events.


- ILI & Resp Syndrome Historical (COH), page 3: The weekly ILI syndrome count is consistent with the previous week and overall trend has been decreasing/leveling out the past few months. The weekly Resp syndrome count is slightly down from/consistent with the previous week, consistent with previous seasons for the timeframe.
- Respiratory Diagnoses Historical (COH), page 4: The weekly flu, RSV, and COVID-19 diagnosis counts are slightly down from/consistent with the previous week and have been decreasing the past several weeks.
- Current Respiratory Diagnoses with Wastewater data, page 5: the weekly influenza diagnosis count is consistent with the previous week and the wastewater level is up from previous week (and has been on an increasing trend for the past 6 weeks). The RSV diagnosis count and wastewater level are slightly up from/consistent with the previous week. The COVID-19 diagnosis count and the wastewater level are down from the previous week (both have been trending down for the past couple of months).
- Current Flu Season with Texas and National trends, pages 6: Both national and Texas counts of positive influenza tests by clinical laboratories and ILINet % of visits for ILI are potentially leveling out/trending down after weeks of increasing trends.
- Demographics of Flu Diagnoses for COH (past 5 weeks), page 7: a majority of the current seasons flu diagnoses in the past 5 weeks in COH are children ages 5 to 17 and this age group and children under 5 age group have the highest ILI visit percentages. Males and females make up close to equal proportions of flu diagnoses. Hispanic followed by NH Black make up a majority of flu diagnoses for the past 5 weeks. The highest ILI visit percentage is seen in Hispanic followed by NH Black make up a majority of flu diagnoses for the past 5 weeks. - Page 8 & 9 are the same figures shown in pages 3 and 4, except the display trends for the whole PH6/5S region, which currently mirror the trends of COH.




# ILI & Resp Syndrome during Flu Season: 2023-2024 and previous 5 years










**SEX: % Distribution for Current Season**






SEX: % Flu of Total Visits by Week




#### **RACE-ETHNICITY: % Distribution for Current Season**

#### **RACE-ETHNICITY: % Flu of Total Visits by Week**




