If the ambulance transporting you or your loved one does NOT have a City of Houston Decal, it has NOT been inspected by a **Houston Health Department Inspector.**



Our EMS Program focuses on:

- Inspecting to ensure the unit is in sanitary and in safe conditions
- Improving patient outcome in the City
- Ensuring Ambulances have the essential equipment for safe transport
- Ensuring ambulance drivers are listed and permitted with the Health Department to drive.

Spotting and reporting illegal ambulances:

Ambulances permitted to operate in the City of Houston have a Houston Health Department Decal affixed in the back right window or door. Drivers must also obtain a Driver ID from City of Houston.

If an ambulance does not have a decal, take a picture, note the address, date and time, and email this info to:

Emergency is strictly an HFD duty. Our Permit allows Private ambulance to transport patients for Non-Emergency.
